Use of Generic Refinish Products

There is still temptation to use “Generic Refinish Products.” This not the wisest choice for a body shop for the following reasons:

- 1.) Each different paint manufacture’s products are formulated and designed to work together to provide maximum performance.
- 2.) Isocyanates, solvents, catalyst, primers, etc. are more than what is used to atomize and transfer the product to the surface. Each of these items becomes a permanent part of the film or contributes to the integrity, adhesion, and /or appearance of the finished job.
- 3.) Each different paint manufacture’s testing and recommendations of product use is done with its system’s components. Introducing a “generic or foreign” item to this mix can severely affect your results immediately and / or down the road.
- 4.) Common issues that are encountered with the use of “generics” have been blistering, gloss, holdout, adhesion, durability, and appearance.

Is the small amount that is saved on using a “generic” worth having to redo a job or even more importantly your shop’s reputation???
