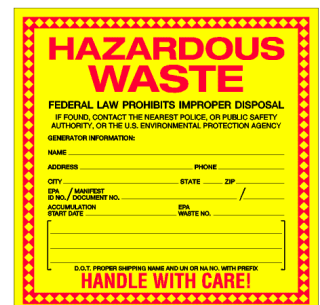
Hazardous Waste: Handling and Storage

- Hazardous waste must be kept in a closed metal container
- Recycler still bottoms must be stored and disposed of as a hazardous waste.
- Waste container funnels must be kept closed when not in use.
- Transfer containers must be grounded to prevent static electricity.
- Waste containers must be kept within an approved spill containment system.
- Different types of waste materials (such as paint waste, oil, or antifreeze) should not be mixed.
- The Hazardous Waste Inspection Log must be updated weekly.
- Hazardous waste must be properly shipped within 180 days. Large quantity generators (LQG) should ship waste within 90 days.
- Do not accumulate empty drums; dispose of them properly.
- Keep waste batteries covered & off the ground.



Labeling requirements (*Obtain labels from hazardous waste hauler*):

- Paint waste containers must be labeled "Hazardous Waste".
- Paint waste label must include the product name, shop's EPA ID#, and accumulation start date (the date the first drop of waste was put into the container).
- Oil must be labeled as "Used Oil".
- Antifreeze must be labeled as "Waste Antifreeze".
